EDAC Awards

Best Student Abstract Awards

Eligibility: Available to EDAC abstract authors who are currently enrolled in a graduate, post-graduate or medical education training program.

Award: Two awards, in the amount of the conference registration fee, will be given to the highest-ranking student abstract submissions. The recipients of the awards will be recognized during the EDAC conference.

Submission instructions: Please check off the box in the submission portal to indicate that you are a student and would like to be considered for the award.

Patient-Oriented Framework Abstract Award

Eligibility: Available to EDAC abstract authors who are submitting research involving a patient oriented framework.

Award: One award, in the amount of the conference registration fee, will be given to the top ranked abstract that involves research using a patient oriented framework. This can include research that engages patients and their caregivers as partners, focuses on patient-identified priorities and/or improves patient outcomes. Engagement refers to collaboration throughout the research process in such areas as priority setting, study design, analysis and knowledge translation.

Submission instructions: Please check off the box in the submission portal that you would like to be considered for the patient oriented framework award. You will then be prompted to provide a short description of how your abstract meets these criteria.
